Month reflects the overlap of Terry and Steve as Executive Directors [last month] and the payment of Terry's finiquito. Admin also includes the addition of the development director, a position that was not included in the budget. Membership, donations and

fundraising ahead of budget, while programs and directory are below.

Year to date [YTD] LCS is now below budget for the year but has paid finiquitos for an Executive Director, Gardener, Commission salesperson and the Que Ganga manager. This has been possible because membership [\$769k]and investment income [\$160k] are ahead of budget. Programs(net) is \$97k below budget, The directory sales are still below budget and fundraising is close to budget on a net basis.
