Course Syllabus, Level 2-A

During the course, four language skills will be worked on: reading comprehension, listening comprehension, oral expression, and written expression. Grammar structures and vocabularies are taught in a practical and communicative way, as well as authentic and fun.

The final objective of this course is: the student will be able to express himself in the following situations with the present and future tenses.

- Communicate basic needs: food, shopping, space.
- Talk about your mood and those of others.
- Give and ask for the time.
- Express obligation.
- Describe everyday objects, people and routines.
- Handle things properly and with confidence in a restaurant or in the city.

Grammatical Structures.

- Gerund and continuous present tense.
- Past tense of the verbs: ser, ir and dar.
- Past tense of regular verbs.
- Past tense of regular verbs due to spelling change.
- Direct and indirect object complement pronouns.

Vocabulary

- La ciudad. (The city)
- Direcciones en la ciudad. (Addresses in the city).
- El banco. (The bank)
- Hablando por teléfono. (Speaking on the phone)

Dialogues.

- ¿Qué estás haciendo? (What are you doing?)
- Cambiando un cheque en el banco. (Cashing a check at the bank.)
- Hablando con un ejecutivo en el banco. (Talking to an executive at the bank.)
- Diálogos breves por teléfono. (Short dialogues on the phone)
- Pidiendo información por teléfono. (Asking for information by phone.)
- Hablando al Laboratorio clínico. (Speaking to the Clinical Laboratory)
