Course Syllabus, Level 3-B

During the course, four language skills will be worked on: reading comprehension, listening comprehension, oral expression, and written expression. Grammar structures and vocabularies are taught in a practical and communicative way, as well as authentic and fun.

The final objective of this course is: the student will be able to express himself in the following situations with the present and future tenses.

- Communicate basic needs: food, shopping, space.
- Talk about your mood and those of others.
- Give and ask for the time.
- Express obligation.
- Describe everyday objects, people and routines.
- Handle things properly and with confidence in a restaurant or in the city.

Grammatical Structures.

- Review of the present indicative.
- Imperative mood. "Usted" (Formal You). In the affirmative and negative forms.
- Imperative mood. "Ustedes" (Plural You). In the affirmative and negative forms.
- Direct and indirect object pronouns together with the Imperative Mood.
- Imperative Mood. "Tú" (informal You). In the affirmative form.
- Imperative Mood. "Tú" (informal You). in the negative form.
